Decree: Saint Joseph Educational Ministries (SJEM), established by the Sisters of St. Joseph of Carondelet (CSJ) to succeed and carry on the educational ministry conducted by Sisters of St. Joseph of Carondelet, St. Louis Province, (Province) upon the petition of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Carondelet, has been granted pontifical public juridic personality by decree of the Congregation for Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life dated January 20, 2020 (prot. no. S. 158⁻¹/2018).

Initial Members: The Province invited 12 persons to begin formation to be the first Members of SJEM. This group met in person in February 2020, for a first session on a CSJ Consensus Statement, a fundamental statement of charism. Due to the pandemic, all other sessions were held via teleconference. Participants met for six sessions of four hours each. See attachment for a list of the dates, topics, presenters and articles covered.

Activities: While 2020 was focused on formation of the first members of SJEM, in Fall 2021, SJEM will host a Sponsorship Day for members of the Province and the educational ministries to continue the tradition established by the Sisters of gathering key persons from the educational ministries for a day focused on Catholic Education and CSJ Values.

Financial: The Province has provided for the financial needs of SJEM. It is expected that in the coming year, SJEM will establish a separate civil corporation and budget.
